<b>COUNTY ADMINISTRATOR</b>	
	Chris DeBolt gave the following updates: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Governor signed Executive Order No. 18 directing every County to perform a comprehensive review of current strategies, policies, procedures, and practices and develop and maintain a plan to identify and confront domestic terrorism, that include racially or ethnically motivated by the extremists. They have until December 31, 2022, to submit the plan to the state. It will include law enforcement, mental health professionals, school officials, and other key stakeholders.</li> <li>• There was a provision in the adopted state budget to provide bonuses for certain frontline health care workers.</li> <li>• The CFA deadline is the end of July.</li> </ul>
