Chairman Baker called the meeting to order at 3:05 pm

Chairman Baker declared Chris DeBolt and Debora Ortloff necessarily absent.

Mr. Phillips made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 20, 2023 meeting. Ms. Moon seconded the motion. The motion carried.

Mr. DeRomanis briefly reviewed their ongoing work.

Ms. Meghan Friedle presented maps of the current main campus site and reviewed the land use and trails. She then reviewed proposed updates by quadrant.

The following are the proposed updates/changes around the Main Campus:

- Northwest Quadrant
  - o Adding security gates and cameras at the trail entrance
  - o Strategic development for the arboretum entrance
  - o Providing better signage and maps
  - o There could be a possibility of partnering with community groups and conservation department to help with trail maintenance
- East Quadrant
  - o Possibly move Woodsmen space and/or tennis courts to the athletics hub on campus
  - o Encourage more community use of fields and tennis courts
- Athletics, Athletic Fields & Parking
  - o Improving D Lot and the roadway
  - o Relocate the greenhouse and Conservation Department
  - o Improving drainage for high flood events
  - o Collaborate with community groups to use the fields during summer months

- o Improve portable water and facilities
- o Create better accessibility and entryway to the gymnasium
- o Improve locker rooms
- o Replace gymnasium floor
- o Update branding
- o Build a one-story addition to Enlarge the fitness center and other areas
- o Build a field house

#### CMAC

- o Getting concert goers to park in the G Lot
- Add restrooms and concessions building
- o Create space for performers parking and storage
- o Upgrade the plaza concrete and complete structural repairs
- o Upgrade the power and utilities
- o Add light poles and dark sky compliant lighting
- o Renovate corridors, green rooms, and install trenching for cabling

### • Greenhouse and Conservation

- o Build a new facility with additional programing and greenhouse space
- o On and Off Campus alternative locations

## • Facility Barn

- o Consider removal or repair of the current barn
- o Demount and replace the current grounds building
- o Modify the salt shed
- o Add a storage yard for mulch, stone, etc.

The committee then provided their initial feedback and concerns to LaBella on the plans that were presented. LaBella asked that the committee to continue to review the plans and provide additional feedback within the next two weeks.

Being there was nothing else to come before the committee, at 5:16 pm, Ms. Geise motioned to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mr. Harvey. The motion carried.
