They had their first meeting at Eastview Mall which was very successful. The next meeting will be held on Thursday, December 8th at 10:30 am at Quail Summit in Canandaigua. • The telecommuters training is underway. • They are sending three people into the Monroe County Basic Police Academy starting next week.
