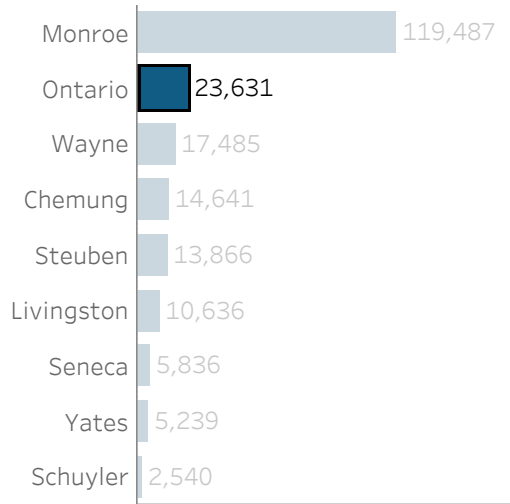


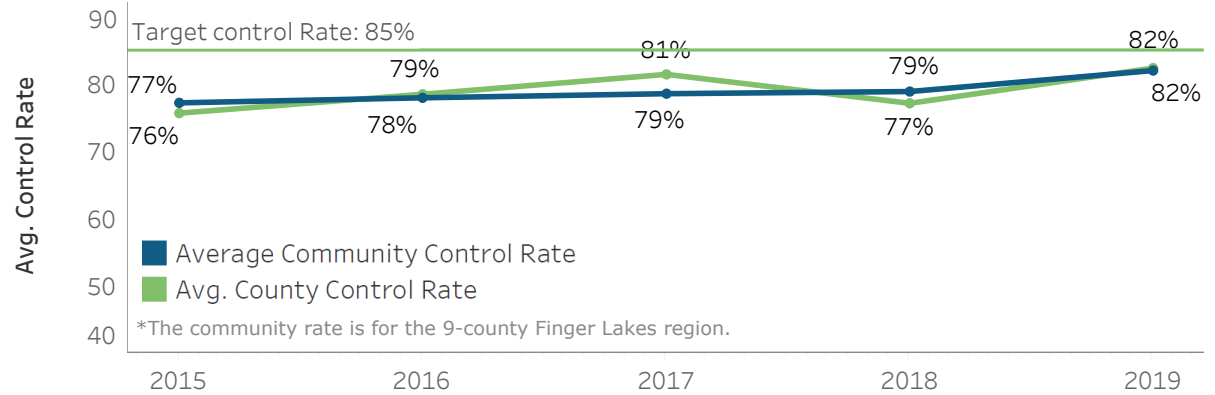

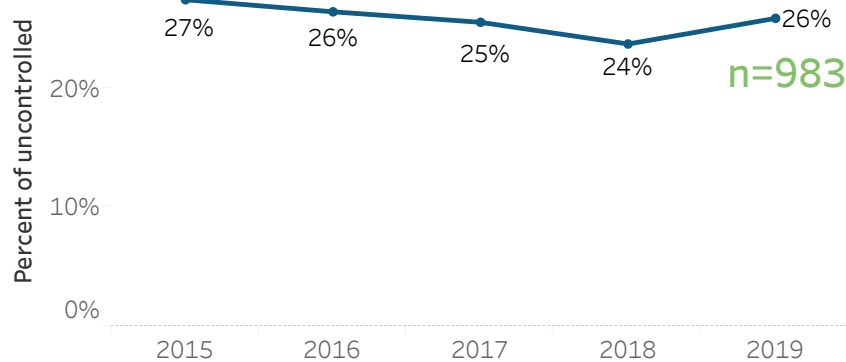


Ontario County Control Rate Compared to the Community

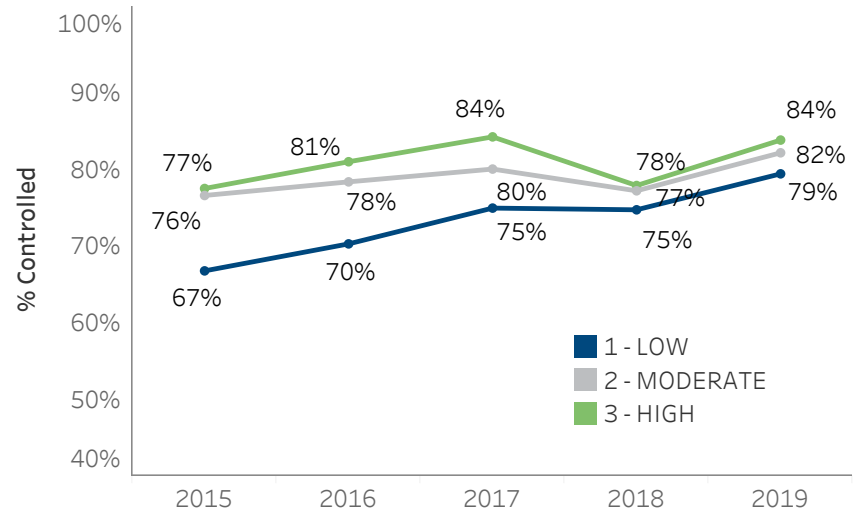

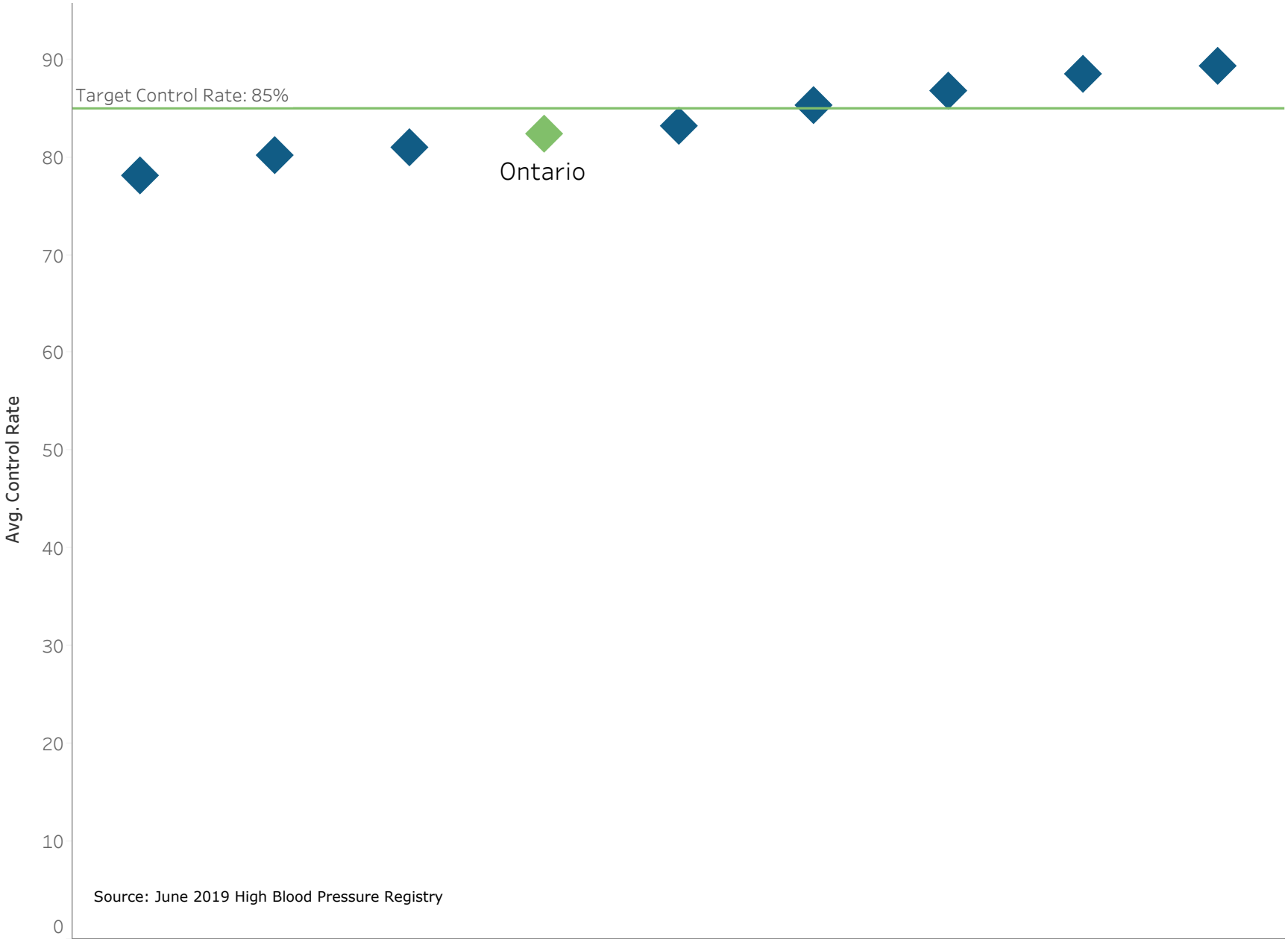
Percent of patients diagnosed with uncontrolled blood pressure whose reading was ≥ 160/100



Ontario County Control Rate by SES Over Time



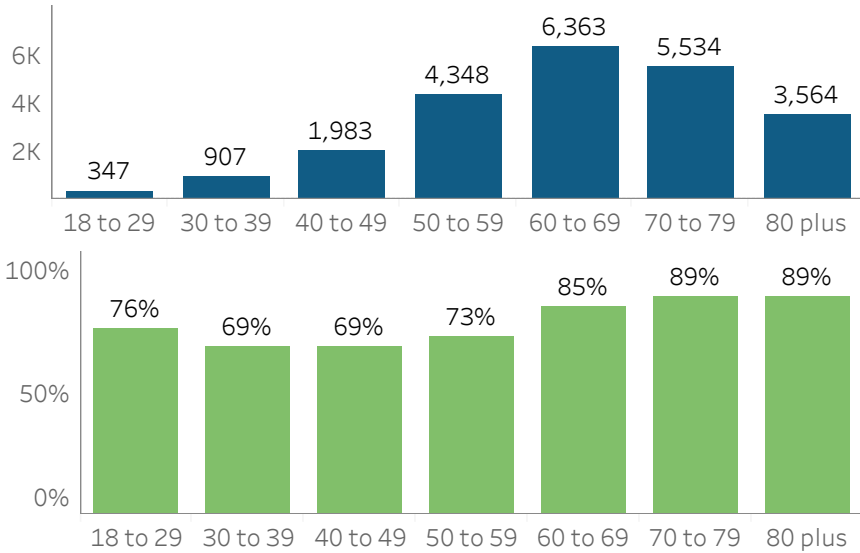
Percent of Patients with Blood Pressure Controlled Ontario



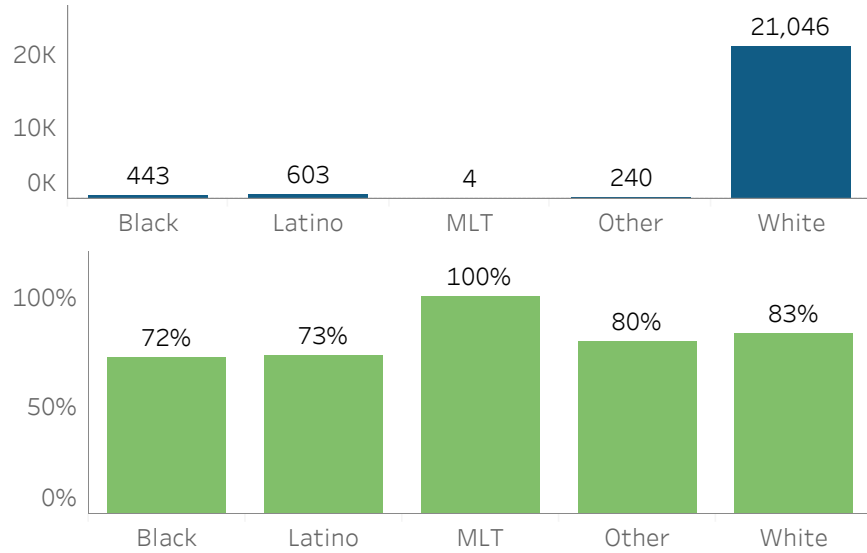

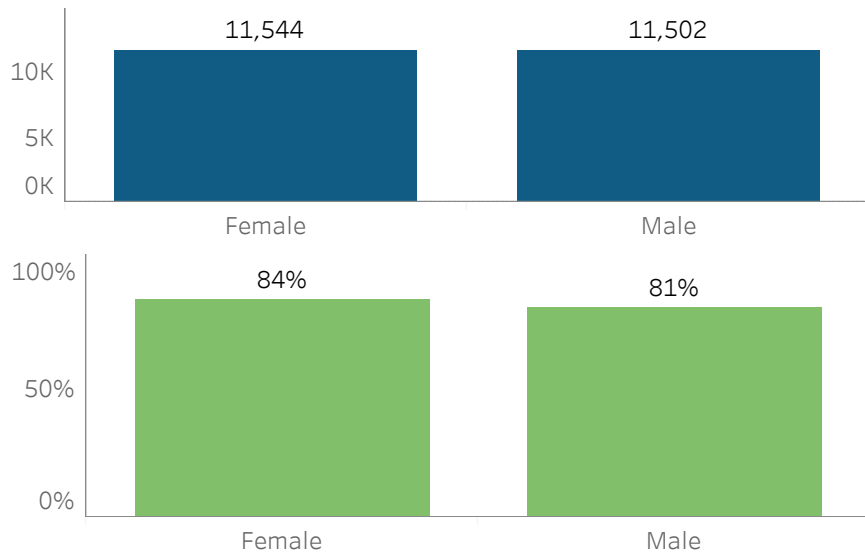
By Age Group



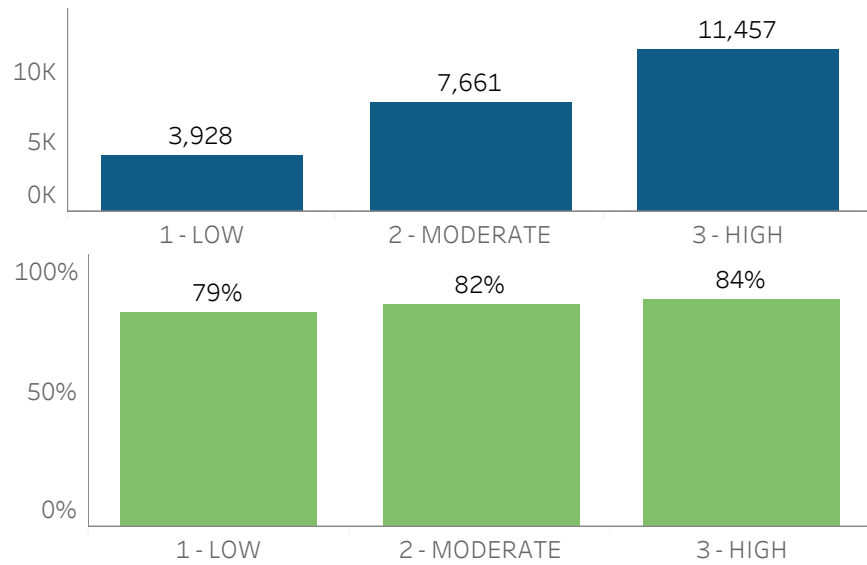
By Race/Ethnicity



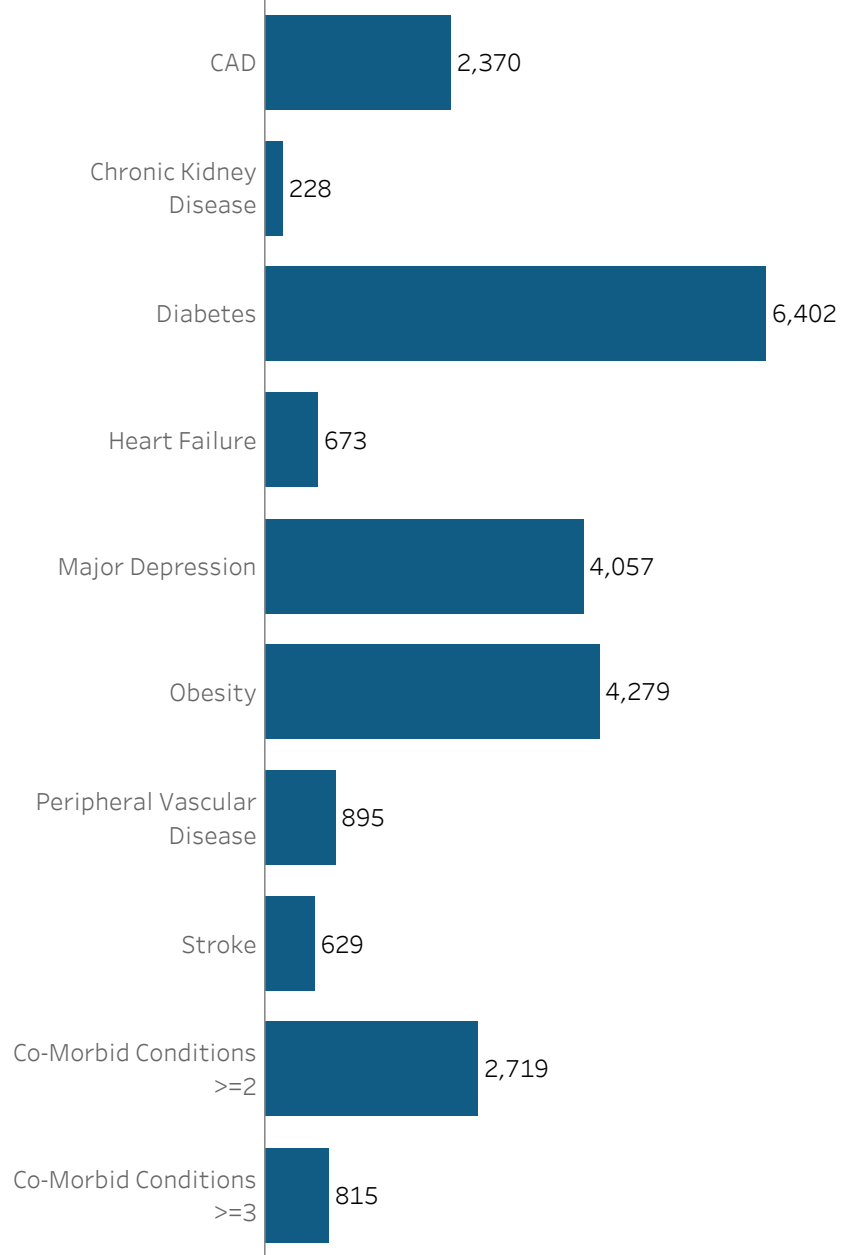
By Gender



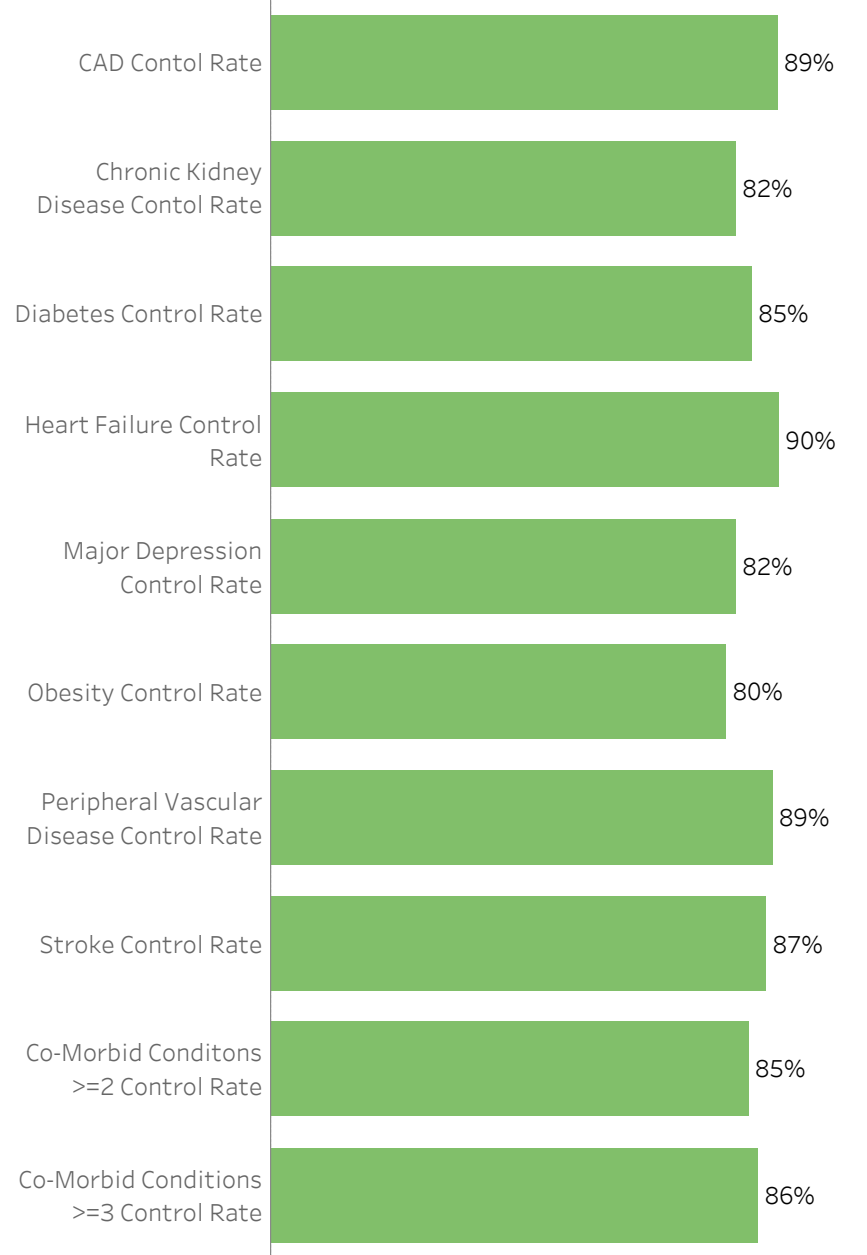
By Socioeconomic Status



Number in Registry with Co-Morbid Condition(s):

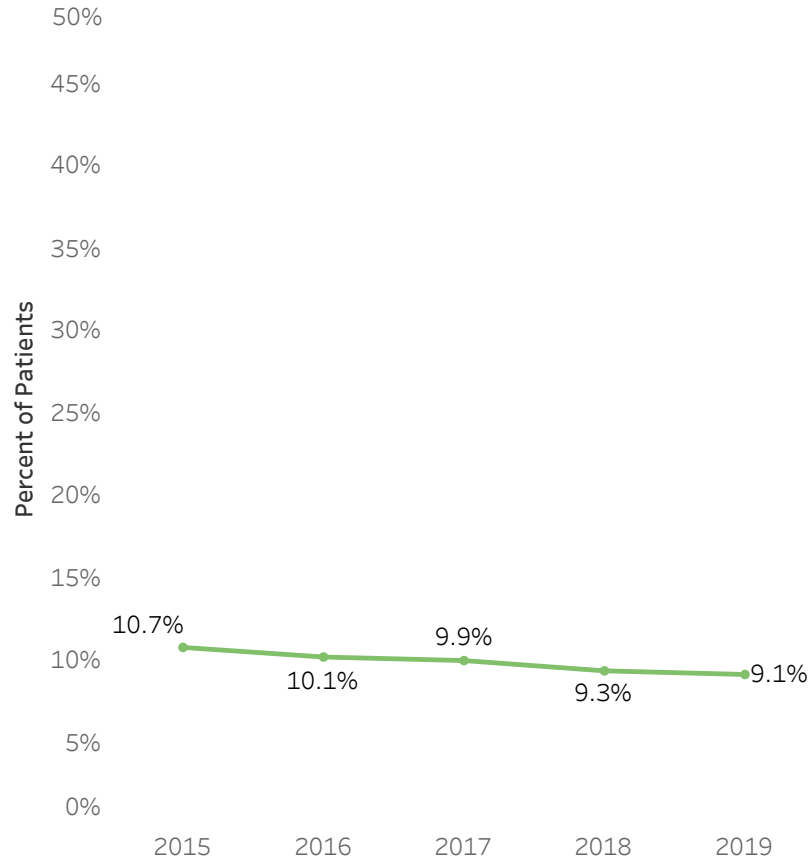


Percent of Controlled Hypertensives with Co-Morbid Condition(s):

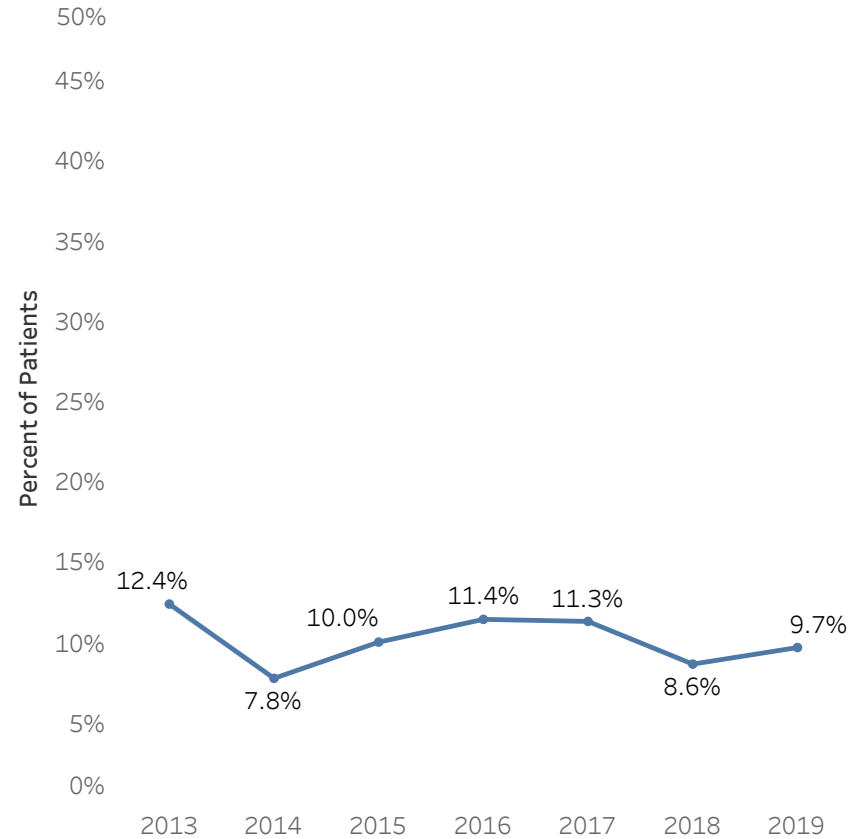


No Current Readings* Among All Patients

9 County Finger Lakes Region



*No current read is defined as the number of patients diagnosed with high blood pressure in the practice who have not had a blood pressure recorded in the medical record within the past 13 months.

Community Patients = patients in 9 county region

Evidence based approaches to the management of high blood pressure that can save lives:

1. Bring patients back every four to six weeks until their blood pressure is controlled.
2. Use once-a-day generic medications whenever possible.
3. If multiple medications are required, use once-a-day combination pills.
4. Create a program in your office to ensure accurate measurement and recording of blood pressure.
5. Encourage home blood pressure monitoring and/or out of office reading at public blood pressure kiosks.
6. Bring hypertensive patients who have not visited the office in a year back for a reading.
7. Encourage use of team based care in your practice.
